Mike Bohn joined DAU in November 2009 as a Professor of Acquisition Management.

Prior to joining DAU, Mr. Bohn was the Chief of Staff and Director of the Technology Division at the Marine Corps Warfighting Lab. In this capacity, he managed the day to day activities of the Warfighting Lab and was responsible for discovering and managing emerging technologies to support future Warfighting experiments and current Warfighter needs.

From June 2004 to June 2008, Mr. Bohn served as the Director, Marine Corps Operational Test and Evaluation Activity, Quantico, VA. In this capacity he served as the Marine Corps Operational Test Agency Commander, responsible for all Marine Corps operational test activities and policies.

Prior to attending Top Level School with the State Department, Mr. Bohn was the Program Manager, Assault Amphibian Vehicles, Marine Corps Systems Command from February 2001 until August 2003.

He was the Operational Test Project Officer for the Advanced Amphibious Assault Vehicle, Marine Corps Operational Test and Evaluation Activity from May 2000 to February 2001, in preparation for the program's Milestone B decision.

From June 1998 to May 2000, Mr. Bohn was the Director, Amphibious Vehicle Test Branch, Camp Pendleton, CA. Prior to June of 1998, Mr. Bohn served in a variety of Operating Forces and Supporting Establishment billets as a Marine Corps Assault Amphibian Officer.

Mr. Bohn is a 1980 graduate of the University of Colorado, with a BA degree in History and 1992 graduate of the University of Nebraska, with a MA in History. He is a 2001 graduate of DSMC's Advanced Program Management Course and is DAWIA Level III certified in Program Management.
