Ms. Roberta M. Tomasini is a professor of Business, Cost Estimating, and Financial Management (BCEFM), Defense Acquisition University (DAU), Fort Belvoir, Virginia. She joined DAU in July 1998. She has taught in many of the financial management courses to include BCF 103, BCF 211, BCF 301, and BCF 101. She has also taught the financial management sessions in program management courses to include, PMT 302 (APMC), PMT 401, PMT 352, PMT 403 (PMSC), PMT 402 (EPMC), ACQ 201 (ISAC), ACQ 403 (DAEOW), ACQ 404 (SAMC), and ACQ 405 (ERC). Currently, she is assigned to the School of Program Management and teaches the financial management, earned value, and cost blocks in the executive level courses. Also, she is the course manager for ACQ 405, the Executive Refresher Course (ERC).

Prior to joining DAU, Lt Col Tomasini was assigned to SAF/AQXR at the pentagon. There, she was chief of the Budget Execution and Financial Management Branch. Her branch was responsible for the funding flow and unfunded requirements of Air Force RDT&E, aircraft procurement, and missile procurement appropriated accounts.

Prior assignments include working budget execution for space programs at Los Angeles AFB, CA 1980-1983. She was a master's degree student at the Air Force Institute of Technology (AFIT) 1983-1984. She stayed at Wright-Patterson AFB, OH and did cost estimating for tactical reconnaissance programs 1984-1987. Then, she was reassigned to the Air Force Manpower and Personnel Center (AFMPC) as an assignment officer for research and development engineers 1988-1991. Her first assignment to SAF/AQXR was 1992-1994 as the Air Force's unfunded requirements financial manager for RDT&E, aircraft procurement, and missile procurement accounts. This was followed with a by-name-request assignment to the F-22 program office to the Financial Management Division 1994-1997. Her second assignment to SAF/AQXR was 1997-1998. There, she ran the branch she had worked in earlier in her career. Ms. Tomasini retired from the Air Force in 2002.

She earned a bachelor of science degree in Education (Math major) from Southwest Texas State University in 1980 and a master of science degree in Systems Management from the AFIT in 1984. Ms. Tomasini completed Squadron Officer School in 1983, the Defense Systems Management Course in 1991, and Air Command and Staff College in 1995. She is level III in Program Management and Level III in Financial Management.
